

Directional signs will be displayed at the car park entrance and also on the corner of Hellawell Rd and Hillcrest St. Sideboard signs, similar to election type boards have also been produced and will be available for use when we are away from the shed—fetes etc. The funds to pay for these signs have been made available by the community support of Mark Stewart, MP ;Kim Marx, Councillor for Karawatha Ward; and Freya Ostapovitch MP

We received a donation of 3 wood lathes, band saws and a few other pieces of equipment from Mabel Park High School (surplus to requirements) . Finding storage space until

in need of repair. They had been restored and put aside to sell at sometime in the future to assist our shed's finances. Bev saw them, made a donation, and left happily with exactly what she was looking for. Yes, we could have made what was required, but not within the 10 minute time frame that it took for this transaction to be completed.
