Fancy a Bowl?



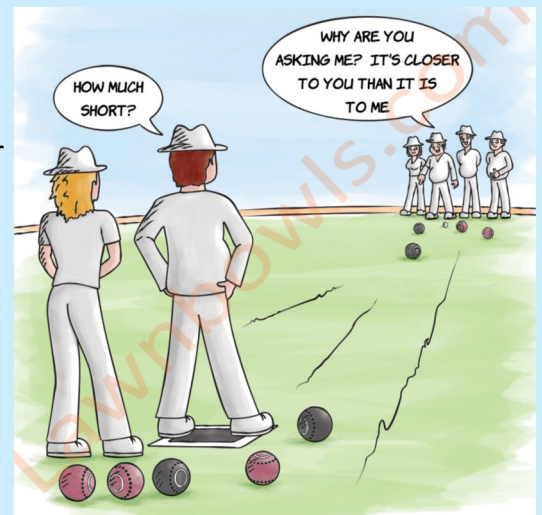
Have you ever considered having a crack at bowling?
