So far we have a new switchboard with safety switches, the table saw hard-wired, 7 suspended outlets as well as two 15 amp outlets for the sander & thicknesser, double power points along one wall & near the personal door & 2 double power points outside and one led light installed. He has also wired up the office and installed a light there.

Still to come will be 3 more led lights in the new shed, 2 leds in the old shed and one in the covered area, double power points along the other wall, the bandsaw to be hard-wired and a weatherproof power point near the container. Well done, John!
