May your hopes and dreams for this New Year come true!!!






What's the Buzz?

Did you know...?

- There are 6 species of European Bees in Australia
- There are 1660 species of Solitary Native Bees
 - But only 11 species of Social Native Bees
 - Worker Bees live for one year
- The European Queen Bee lays 1500 eggs per day
- In the European Bee hive 1500 bees die each day
 - The Native Queen Bee lays 300-400 eggs per day
- In the Native Bee hive 300-400 bees die each day
- Ten species of Native Bees can't sting, but can bite
 - Stingless Native Bees live only in N.S.W. & Qld
 - Native Bees live in all parts of Australia
 - The Native Queen Bee never leaves her hive
- * The European Worker Bee flies up to 8 km each day
 - The Native Worker Bee flies only 500 metres each day


This shed is the initiative of the Sunnybank RSL Sub Branch and the Sunnybank Uniting Church.


