# **My Health Record**

My Health Record is the national digital health record system. This means your important health information like allergies, medical conditions and treatments, medicine details and test or scan reports can be digitally available in one place. Healthcare providers like doctors, specialists and hospital staff may be able to see it online from anywhere at any time when they need to, like in an accident or emergency. As more people use this system, Australia's national health system will become better connected. This will result in faster and more efficient care for you and your family.

There are strict rules on who can see and use your My Health Record. You don't need to worry about having to remember and repeat your health history to different healthcare providers. You can access your health information from a computer, tablet or mobile device.
