A Project For Our Community



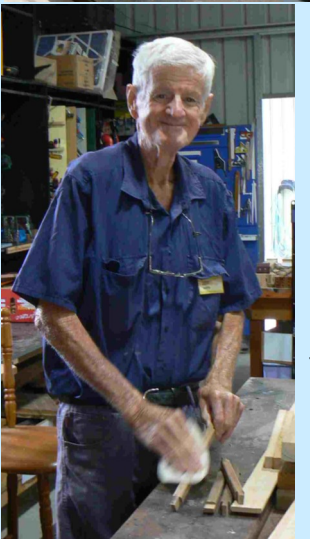

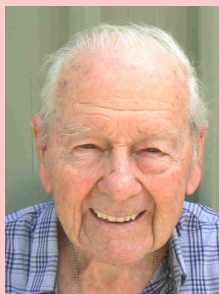
Like-Minded Men

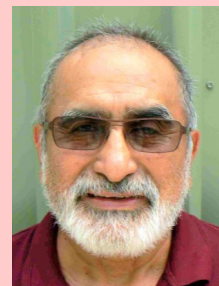
