Could it be a sign of greater things to come?



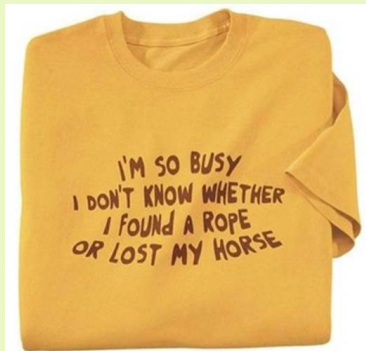
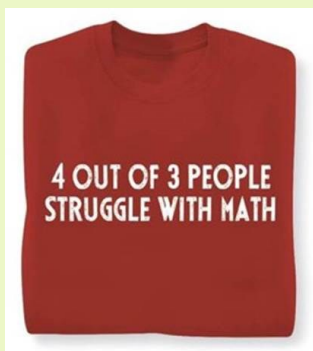
Where to from here?
